Strategic Insights

Strategic Insights

Residents view the Shire of Donnybrook Balingup as a good place to live and visit, though there is room to address perceptions of governance:

- As a place to live, the performance index score is 77 out of 100, 2 index points above average for similar councils.
- As a place to visit, the performance index score is 68 out of 100, 1 index point below average for similar councils.
- As a **governing organisation**, the performance index score is 47; 3 index points below average for similar councils.

Playgrounds, parks and reserves are considered a strength in the Shire of Donnybrook Balingup. Other high performance areas include library and information services and sport and recreation facilities. Relative to similar councils, the Shire is leading in 7 measures and on par or above average in a further 10 areas.

The community would like the Shire to focus on three **key priorities**:

- 1. Openness and transparency of Council processes
- 2. How the community is consulted about local issues
- 3. Tourism attractions and marketing

Secondary priorities include local roads, Council's leadership within the community, conservation and environmental management, economic development, how local history and heritage is preserved and promoted, and footpaths, trails and cycleways.

The 'Overall Performance Index Score' is a combined measure of the Shire of Donnybrook Balingup as a 'place to live' and as a 'governing organisation'. The Shire of Donnybrook Balingup's overall performance index score is 62 out of 100, 1 index point below the average of like councils.


Overall Performance Index Score


How to read the MARKYT ♦ Benchmark Matrix TM

The MARKYT® Benchmark Matrix TM (shown in detail overleaf) illustrates how the community rates performance on individual measures, compared to how other councils are being rated by their communities.


There are two dimensions. The vertical axis maps community perceptions of performance for individual measures relative to the average score for all measures. The horizontal axis maps performance relative to the MARKYT® Industry Standards.

This line represents Council's average performance for all individual measure.
As it represents the average, around half of the service areas will be placed above the line, and around half will be positioned below the line.

Councils aim to be on the right side of this line, with performance ABOVE the MARKYT® Industry Standard.


MARKYT Community Priorities Window TM


Playgrounds, parks and reserves is the highest performing area with an average rating of 'good'.


Moving forward, the community would like Council to prioritise being open and transparent, consulting the community about local issues and tourism attractions and marketing (orange markers Window G).

The Study

The Study

In January-February 2019, the Shire of Donnybrook Balingup administered a MARKYT® Community Scorecard to evaluate community priorities and measure Council's performance against key indicators in the Strategic Community Plan.

Scorecard invitations were sent to all residential addresses in Australia Post's unaddressed mail database.


The Shire supported the survey with promotions through its communication channels, including the website, newsletters and social media.

In total, **441 responses** were received.

Of these responses, 28 respondents were affiliated with the Shire. They were either working for the Shire as an employee or Elected Member or they were living with a Shire employee or Elected Member. As analysis of responses from Shire affiliated and non-affiliated produced very different results, results have been reported separately. The main body of the report presents responses from the non-affiliated sample.

The final dataset was weighted by age and gender to match the ABS Census population profile.

Data has been analysed using SPSS. Where sub-totals add to $\pm 1\%$ of the parts, this is due to rounding errors to zero decimal places.





MARKYT Industry Standards | like council subset

The MARKYT® Community Scorecard has been conducted by a large and diverse group of councils across Western Australia. While it is beneficial to see how council is performing compared to other councils across Western Australia, benchmarking goes to the next level and provides greater relevance and meaning when we compare apples with apples.

Councils have an opportunity to benchmark performance against a subset of similar councils. The Shire of Donnybrook Balingup has chosen to compare its performance to four like councils, the Shires of Capel, Dandaragan, Denmark and York.










