9.2 – OEM District Emergency Management Advisor Report

Vik Cheema provided an overview of the Australian Disaster Resilience Handbook (Community Recovery) and provided a copy to the CESM. Further discussion held of the changes to the Office of Emergency Management coming within the Department of Fire & Emergency Services and the restructure of the new Rural Fire Division.

9.3 – St John Ambulance

Ian explained that the local St John Ambulance Sub-Centre had redeveloped their building and was now operational. This includes the facilities to run meetings and incidents if needed.

9.4 - Shire of Donnybrook

Leigh advised that the State Risk Project was being completed and the CESM would update the committee at the next meeting regarding risks and treatment options

9.5 - Donnybrook Hospital

Robin requested the CESM attend the hospital to discuss bushfire risk

9.6 - State Emergency Services

Carol advised the committee that the SES are low on members and actively recruiting Wear Orange Wednesday WOW day was the 23rd May and the SES having an open day, all welcome to attend.

9.7 - Volunteer Fire & Rescue (VFRS)

Ben reported that the VFRS had a busy month with 14 incidents including 1 fatal car accident, member numbers are good.

9.8 - Bushfire Mitigation Officer

Ben advised that Mitigation Activity Fund (MAF) for FY17-18 was on track to complete within the shire, grant submission for FY18-19 being planned.

9.9 - Department of Fire & Emergency Services

Steve spoke about the changes to the Rural Fire Division (RFD) and that Superintendant Tillman has been seconded away, Danny Mosconi is acting Supt. DFES undertaking structural fire pre-plans at key public facilities - hospital and nursing homes and that DFES are looking to refurbish the VFRS station in Donnybrook. Steph – advised that she hopes to increase the number of bushfire ready groups, Donnybrook-Balingup has 13-14 and she is willing to support more in the shire, training courses coming up in June at Bridgetown and DFES is looking at a winter burning workshop in Balingup soon.

9.10 Bush Fire Service

Max advised it was a quiet season which has picked up when the season was lifted with a number of escaped private burns occurring.

The committee discussed options for a local emergency exercise, it was decided a sub group made up of the head of Police, VFRS, SJA, SES and the CESM would meet to plan exercise and report back to the next LEMC meeting.
